Clubhouse Update

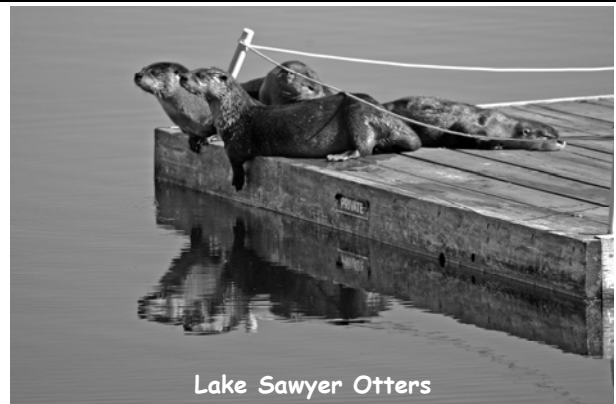
